As readers and writers, we will:

- Read Varjak Paw by SF Said as our class shared reading as well as reading sessions to explore the text in greater depth.
- Write a setting description about an ancient tomb.
- Create a report about Howard Carter and his discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb.
- Create a narrative based upon our core text, Varjak Paw.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will:

Length and perimeter:

- Convert between different units of measure [for example, kilometre to metre; hour to minute]
- Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear figure (including squares) in centimetres and metres
- Find missing lengths in rectilinear shapes.
- Calculate perimeter of rectilinear shapes.
- Find the perimeter of regular polygons.

Science

As Scientists we shall be learning all about animals (including humans).

This half term we will continue to:

- describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans
- identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions
- Classify vertebrates and plants and apply our understanding to classification keys.

History

As Historians we will be exploring Ancient Egypt, specifically:

- Ancient Egyptian society.
- The evolution of the Pyramids.
- Howard Carter and the discovery of Tutankhamun's Tomb.
- Why the Egyptians used mummification.
- Ancient Egyptian religion.
- Civilisations in Ancient Egypt.
