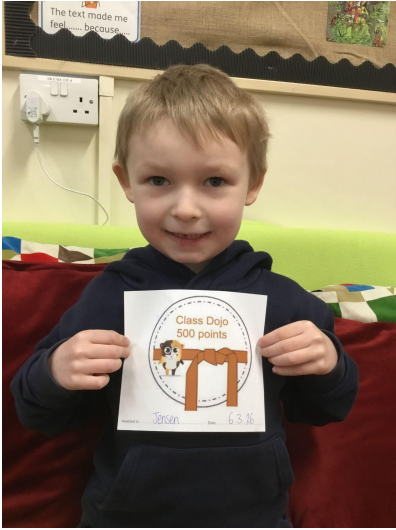
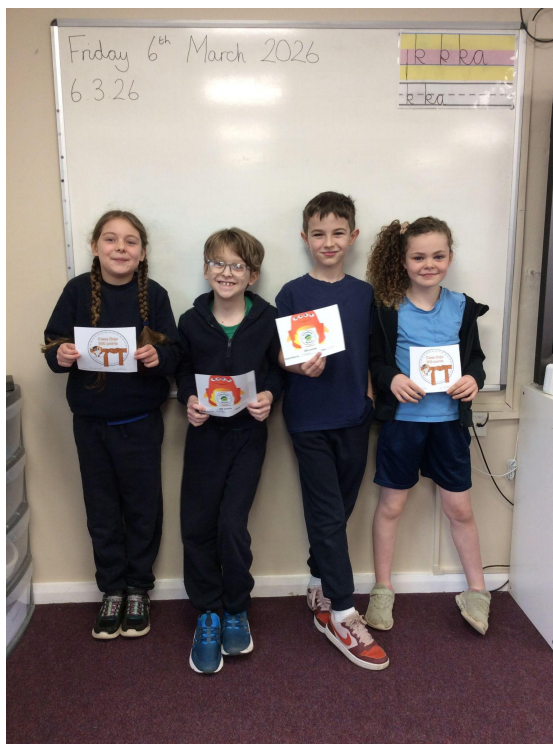




Competition

Conversations with staff

Parking

A polite reminder about parking. Only parents with blue badges are permitted to park in the staff car park. The only exceptions are collecting a child when ill or dropping off heavy items. Running late, or no parking spaces in the village hall, is not a valid reason.
