Diarrhoea and vomiting

We are aware of an awful stomach bug that has been spreading through our school. It is essential that parents to do their part to stop the spread. Please read the NHS advice:

NHS advice for a child with a sickness bug (vomiting/diarrhoea) is to manage it at home by encouraging fluids (little and often), ensuring plenty of rest, and maintaining hygiene to prevent spread. Keep children off school/nursery for 48 hours after symptoms stop. Seek medical help if signs of dehydration appear or symptoms last more than 3 days

Key Advice for Parents:

- Prevent Dehydration: Encourage frequent small sips of water, milk, or diluted squash. For babies, continue normal feeds.
- Oral Rehydration Solutions (ORS): [Pharmacists](#) can recommend ORS sachets to replace lost salts.
- Food: Don't force food, but offer plain, 111, non-fatty options (bread, rice, pasta) if they are hungry.
- Hygiene: Wash hands frequently with soap and water. Disinfect toilet handles, taps, and surfaces daily.
- School/Nursery: Keep children home for 48 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea.

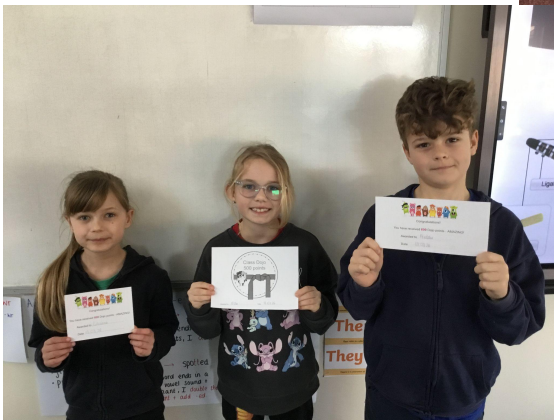
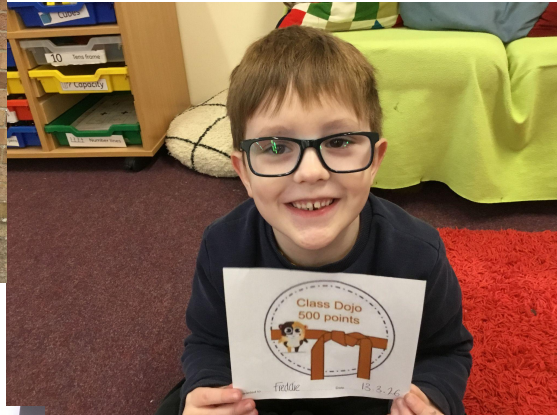
